INFORMATION/REPORTS

- a. C. Clark gave an update on park projects.
  - The pickleball court project at Kiwanis Park has begun. Village staff has installed the new net posts. The surfacing work by the contractor is expected to be done by the end of July.
  - The Green Isle Park parking lot reconstruction project will begin on July 13<sup>th</sup> with completion anticipated by September 15<sup>th</sup>.
  - Kayak launches for Green Isle Park and Kayaker's Point are going to be ordered in the beginning of July.
- b. The Village received a grant from the Fox River/Green Bay Natural Resource Trustee Council (NRDA) for kayak launches in the amount of \$28,650.
- c. C. Clark gave an update on the Allouez Park and Facilities COVID-19 Reopening Plan.
- d. The Fox-Wolf Watershed Cleanup Day has been rescheduled to August 22<sup>nd</sup>. More information on this can be found on their website at [www.fwwa.org](http://www.fwwa.org).
- e. The Bethel Baptist Pond Project that the Allouez Public Works Department will be constructing this summer will include installation of a storm water pipe along the north side
