§ 302-5 : The use of sound amplifiers outside buildings within the Village of Allouez is prohibited without a permit to do so from the Village. The Village shall not grant a permit to use a sound amplifier during nighttime hours (10:00 p.m. to 7:00 a.m.) or to operate such sound amplifier in the vicinity of health facilities, churches while services are being conducted, or schools which are in session. The Village may order a reduction in the volume of such sound amplification on complaint being made by a citizen or when such sound amplification is a nuisance because of the volume, the method in which it is being used, or the location in which it is being operated.

Noise Variance Permit Application Request Doug's Take5 Summer Concert:

On April 19th, 2021, I, Deputy J. Vogel, spoke with Doug's Take5 owner James Meikle at 3600 Riverside Dr. James has recently completed a Noise Variance Permit Application for a benefit summer concert to be held on June 5th, 2021, from the hours of 7pm to 10pm. This is an annual benefit with proceeds going towards Howe Elementary School reading program and various YMCA programs.

To my knowledge this annual event has caused no incidents reported to the police. James reports he is hiring security to monitor the event. As past years James will be blocking off the entrance from Riverside Dr to avoid congestion on this busy roadway. James has spoken with the neighboring Dairy Queen for extra parking if needed. James states the music speakers will be pointed away from the apartment complexes next door. James assures me the music will stop at 10:00pm. James will have his cell phone on him at all times in case the village or Brown County Sheriff's Office needs to get in touch with him. James is expecting 300 people to attend.
